

How to take care of your Roses

Carefully remove the packaging sleeve as soon as possible, cut the base of the stems & place them into a clean vase with fresh water. Do not overcrowd the container, allowing individual blooms to have space to open nicely. Use a tall container to hold and support the rose stems.

If the roses are not being kept in a cool room keep the roses in natural light and away from direct sunlight. Avoid placing roses near heating and cooling units. Trying to force the blooms to open quicker can cause damage.

Avoid water or moisture wetting the petals and blooms. Do not spray or mist water on the rose heads as this may cause damage. To extend vase life we suggest replacing with fresh water every few days.
